

Chin-Ming Chen, M.D., Professor

Prof. Chen is the current Supervisor of Taiwan Society of Emergency & Critical Care Medicine (TSECCM), Taiwan, R.O.C. He currently working as Associate Director of Center for Quality Management and Professor at Department of Intensive Care Medicine, Chi-Mei Medical Center, Tainan, Taiwan.

After graduating from China Medical University, Taichung, Taiwan in 1994/6, he completed his residency training in Chi-Mei Medical Center, Tainan, Taiwan and got the Board of Medical Doctor in 1994, and Specialist of Internal Medicine in 1998. He received his Board of Subspecialist of Emergency & Intensive Care Medicine in 2000 and Pulmonary & Critical Care Medicine in 2001. He was a post-doctoral research fellow in the Keenan Research Centre for Biomedical Science of St. Michael's Hospital, Toronto University in 2007. He has been the Associate Director of Center for Quality Management and Professor at Department of Intensive Care Medicine, Chi-Mei Medical Center from Jan. 2018 till now.

Dr. Chen is not only specialized as a Pulmonologist but also an intensivist and instructors of critical care medicine and advanced cardiac life support (ACLS). Currently, Dr. Chen is the Associate Editor of *Resuscitation & Intensive Care Medicine* (An official journal of TSECCM). He is also the Committee Chair of Medical Quality and Patient Safety in TSECCM. He got the several awards of Healthcare Quality Improvement Campaign (HQIC) in Taiwan, especially the Gold Award from 133 teams in 2017. He is now the Reviewer of HQIC. He also won the Best Poster Prizes of TSECCM annual conference in 2019, 2018, 2016, 2015, 2014 and 2012. He won the Travel Grants of Korea Society of Critical Care Medicine (KSCCM) in 2018 and 2019. He has more than 50 research projects and more than 70 publications of original articles, case reports, and review papers being published in peer review journals covering research fields of Quality Improvement, Infection, Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine.

He has been invited to be as reviewers for more than 16 English peer review journals, e.g. *Medicine, Scientific Reports, Respiratory Care, International Journal of Clinical Cardiology, and Current Medical Research & Opinion* et al. His research interests include Quality Improvement, Infection, Ventilator, Animal study, Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine. He was also the faculty of EuroAsia Conference in 2017.
